This week's best travel bargains around the globe.

Land

The Windsor Court Hotel, a **luxury property in New Orleans**, has a special through Sept. 30. The Summer Knights deal **starts at \$239** a night, plus about \$40 taxes, and includes a one-bedroom suite upgrade and a **\$50 nightly credit** valid on such amenities as food, drinks, parking and spa treatments. The 1000 Islands Harbor Hotel, a four-diamond property in New York's **Thousand Islands region**, has two summer packages with **10 percent savings**. The **Island Cruise package** starts at \$479 and includes one night's accommodations and a three-hour wine-and-cheese cruise on the St. Lawrence River. The **St. Lawrence Sports package** starts at \$339 and includes lodging, a kayak or bicycle rental for a half-day (two people) or full day (one person), and a \$30 breakfast voucher for the Seaway Grille. For example, save 30 percent on Villa Le Boudoir, a one-bedroom with ocean views; a seven-night stay starts at \$3,570 (plus 15 percent taxes), a savings of \$1,530. Stay through Sept. 30. Sea

Save \$1,000 per person on Abercrombie & Kent's **Cuba by Land & Sea**: A People to People Cruise when you book a Category 1-3 cabin by July 31. The 11-day trip, which has two departures in 2017, starts at \$9,995 per person double for a Category 1 cabin. Price includes pre- and post-cruise hotel stays in Miami, Havana and Santiago de Cuba; a seven-night cruise aboard a boutique sailing vessel; activities including snorkeling at Punta Francés Nature Reserve, a boat ride to Cayo Granma and an architect-led walk through Havana; 28 meals; and taxes. Windstar Cruises is offering **early booking savings** and a **\$150 shipboard credit** per cabin on select 2016 and 2017 **Caribbean, Costa Rica and Panama Canal** itineraries. For example, the seven-night Naturally Costa Rica cruise, which sails round trip from Puerto Caldera on Jan. 14, starts at \$1,799 per person double, plus \$135 port charges and taxes. Air

United has **sale fares to Europe** for travel Aug. 23 through March 31. For example, round-trip fare from Washington Dulles to **Madrid** starts at **\$593**, including taxes. Other airlines are matching, but fare typically starts at about \$900. Holiday blackout dates apply. For lowest fares, depart Monday through Wednesday and return Monday through Thursday. Book by June 7 at united.com.

Package

World Spree is offering its **Amazing Vietnam** tour **from \$1,499** per person double. The 10-night trip includes airfare on China Airlines from New York to Hanoi, with return from Ho Chi Minh City; two domestic flights; two nights at the Sheraton Hanoi; an overnight cruise on Halong Bay; two nights at the Sunrise Beach Resort in Hoi An; two nights at the Imperial Hotel in Hue; three nights at the Hotel Majestic in Ho Chi Minh City; 13 meals; several guided tours with entrance fees; land transport; airport transfers; and taxes.
