This week's best travel bargains around the globe.

Land

- • Book three nights at the all-inclusive Breezes **Bahamas** and receive the **fourth night free**. Rates and savings vary. For example, a four-night stay in a garden-view room through Aug. 8 starts at \$1,296 per couple, a savings of \$432. Price includes lodging, meals, beverages, non-motorized water sports and taxes. - With Extraordinary Journeys Africa, receive a **seven-night safari in Tanzania** for the **price of five nights**. The Tanzania Taste of Safari costs \$6,500 per person double (including taxes), down from \$7,900, and includes three nights at the new Kuro camp in Tarangire National Park, four nights at Nomad's Serengeti Safari Camp, three meals a day and at least a dozen game drives. • Southwest has a sale on fares between BWI Marshall and **Dayton**, Ohio, and between Reagan National and **Atlanta**. Nonstop fare to Dayton is \$178 round trip; other airlines are charging \$197 for connecting flights. Nonstop fare to Atlanta is \$198; other airlines are charging \$270. Book by Feb. 13 at www.southwest.com; fly by May 21. Fourteen-day advance purchase required. Sale does not apply to Friday or Sunday flights.

• Intrepid Vacations is offering an independent tour to **southern Spain** starting at \$1,995 per person double.
