What's new at European museums this spring

Italy's Ferrari Museum will play clips of the vehicles in action paired with the actual car models at its exhibit dedicated to Ferraris on film. Museo Enzo Ferrari Modena

Red Carpet Exhibition at the Museo Enzo Ferrari, Modena, Italy

February 2016 - February 2017

Italy's Ferrari Museum pays homage to the films and television shows that gave the iconic cars starring roles in its Red Carpet Exhibition. On display: the famous 308 GTS from *Magnum P.I.*, the Testarossa from *Miami Vice*, the 512 S from *Le Mans*, and the 375 America driven by Sofia Loren in *Boy on a Dolphin*. Clips of the vehicles in action are paired with the actual car models. Since racing has always come first with Ferrari, there is a focus on track-centered films like *Grand Prix* and, more recently, *Rush*. Off-set, Hollywood legends including Paul Newman, Steve McQueen and Marilyn Monroe adored Ferraris, and Monroe's white 250 GT Cabriolet Pininfarina is part of the exhibit. museomodena.ferrari.com/exhibitions-2
