April 17: French Polynesia's flag carrier **Air Tahiti Nui** is offering discounts of up to 42 per cent on round-trip tickets to Tahiti, **for stays between May 1 and June 24, 2013**. During Air Tahiti Nui's "Spring into Paradise" sale, **which runs until April 30**, a round-trip economy-class ticket from LAX to Papeete, usually \$1,500 and up, is priced from \$898. Air Tahiti Nui flies daily non-stop to Tahiti from Los Angeles, a flight of eight hours. Travelers across the United States can connect to the flight through Air Tahiti Nui's codeshare agreement with American Airlines. April 17: **Frontier Airlines** is running a fare sale from Branson, Kansas City, Oklahoma City and St. Louis to cities in the Western U.S., with one-way fares from \$139 including all applicable transportation fees and taxes. **Tickets must be purchased by 11:59 p.m. ET on April 30. Fares are for travel from April 23 through May 22 and from September 4 through November 13, 2013.** Round-trip purchases are not required, but a seven-day advance purchase is. Sample \$139 sale fares include from Branson to Las Vegas, San Diego and San Francisco; from Kansas City to Phoenix, Seattle and Santa Barbara; Oklahoma City to Orange County, Portland (Oregon) and Salt Lake City; and St. Louis to Portland, San Francisco and Seattle. To book, visit www.FlyFrontier.com, where you will also find the airline's Classic and Classic Plus fares that include two free checked bags, no itinerary change fees, and additional perks and flexibility.

April 17: **Finnair** has launched a fare sale from New York to destinations in Northern and Central Europe. Non-refundable round-trip fares, including all taxes and government fees, vary from \$655 to Tallinn to \$935 to Rovaniemi in Finnish Lapland. Round-trips to Finnair's Helsinki hub at Helsinki start at \$789, which (like many airline fares) is illogical compared to other, lower round-trip fares offered in Finnair's sale because all these itineraries involve the flight to Helsinki and then an additional Finnair flight within Europe. **Sale fares are only available for travel during low season (until April 30 and from October 1 onwards); during spring and summer prices are likely to be higher.** The fares require the use of flight numbers AY006 (from New York JFK non-stop to Helsinki) and AY005 (from Helsinki non-stop

There is a Saturday-night minimum-stay requirement and a maximum-stay requirement of 30 days. **Tickets must be purchased at least three days before departure.** Children between 2 and 11 years of age traveling with an adult receive a discount of 25 per cent off the adult fare before taxes; infants under 2 years of age receive a discount of 90 per cent off the adult fare, before taxes. Fares shown are for weekday departures only. Fares for departures on Fridays through Sundays are \$20 higher each way. Round-trip sale fares are from \$655 to Tallinn; \$659 to Riga; \$670 to Stockholm; \$679 to St. Petersburg; \$695 to Vilnius; \$705 to Warsaw; \$709 to Gothenburg; \$709 to Oslo; \$715 to Copenhagen; \$729 to Moscow; \$735 to Prague; \$735 to Yekaterinburg; \$739 to Budapest; \$789 to Helsinki; and \$935 to Rovaniemi. Finnair is also offering round-trip sale fares in Business Class to the same destinations, beginning at \$2,729 to Tallinn and to Vilnius.
