Finnair rents out Samsung Tab 3 tablets on select flights

Passengers will be able to rent Samsung Tab 3 tablets on Finnair's new Airbus A321s.

For 10 euros (approximately \$13.50 USD), passengers can access dozens of hours of pre-programmed games, videos, music and newspapers.



Finnair has been upgrading its in-flight entertainment offerings. Recently, it doubled its entertainment options to 72 movies and more than 150 TV shows on-demand on long-haul flights.

"Tablet computing clearly has the potential to revolutionize inflight entertainment, as tablet systems are much lighter and easier to keep up to date from an operations point of view, while also offering the customer a much richer and more interactive entertainment experience," says Jouni Oksanen, Finnair's director of customer entertainment. "If tablet-based entertainment proves to be successful on these new aircraft, we will of course continue to evaluate the possibility of implementation across the fleet."
