Finnair will fly an Airbus jet from Helsinki to New York using **recycled cooking oil** to power the engines.

*The flight, which will coincide with the opening day of the United Nations Climate Summit, will be operated using an Airbus A330 and environmentally sustainable biofuel. Provided by SkyNRG Nordic, a joint venture between SkyNRG and Statoil Aviation, the fuel is comprised partly of cooking oil recycled from local restaurants.*
