## Finnair Grows Presence In Thailand

To cater to growing demand, [Finnair](#) will expand its presence in Thailand with the additional weekly services on its Bangkok (BKK) route during the 2014–15 winter season. The national carrier will introduce three more weekly flights from Helsinki (HEL) from Dec. 30, 2014 through March 27, 2015, boasting the route's total frequency to 17 flights a week, the most of any European carrier. The new flights will be operated with two-class Airbus A340 aircraft. "Thailand has long been a popular destination for Finns and other northern Europeans, and adding capacity will help us meet this enduring — and growing — demand," said Pekka Vauramo, CEO, Finnair. "As the European airline with the most weekly frequencies to Bangkok and several other Asian destinations, we are on track to double our revenue from Asian traffic between 2010 and 2020." Finnair's route network in Southeast Asia also includes service to Hanoi (HAN) and Singapore (SIN).
