## Finnair to begin flights from O'Hare

Finland's Finnair will start flying from Chicago's O'Hare International Airport next summer.

Airbus A330s will depart from Chicago and Helsinki on Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays, with flights leaving Chicago at 10 p.m. from June 13 to Oct. 17.

Finnair flies between Asia, Europe and North America, carrying more than 9 million passengers annually, the airline said.

Finnair has won the Skytrax World Airline Award for the best airline in Northern Europe for the past five years.
