Jan. 31

If you think rocks rock, don't miss the **Tucson Gem, Mineral & Fossil Showcase** in Arizona (Jan. 31-Feb. 15) - touted as the world's largest treasure hunt. Feb. 2

At the **2015 FIS Alpine World Ski Championships** (Feb. 2-15), about 700 athletes from 70-plus nations will flock to Vail and Beaver Creek, Colo., to compete in downhill, slalom, individual, and team events.
