This week's best travel bargains around the globe.

Land

Manhattan Walking Tour is taking **20 percent off NYC tours** through the end of the year. The deal applies to its combo and food tours. day trip starts at \$4,249 per person double in a C cabin, \$5,349 for B and \$5,849 for A. Price includes accommodations on a 49-passenger sail cruiser; most meals; airport transfers; and several tours and shore excursions. Not included: round-trip charter flights to Cuba from Miami (\$599, booked through the company), port taxes (\$395) and Cuban visa (\$75). For example, an early November trip to Barcelona starts at \$1,765 per couple, a savings of \$572. Price includes round-trip air from Dulles, accommodations at Citypark Pelayo in the Gothic Quarter and taxes.
