# Families Embark on Nine-Day Exclusive Tour Through Costa Rica

Pricing for this private family tour starts at \$2,590 per person, and at \$1,590 for children 12 years and younger, based on double occupancy, with daily departures. It offers a full itinerary for the whole family to enjoy.



Learning Journeys Family Adventures itineraries afford families with unique experiences that broaden horizons and create a bonding experience. Travelers discover something new together, which builds memories that last far beyond the travel experience.

Sample highlights of the private nine-day Costa Rica Family Discovery include, but are not limited to:

Day four, travelers delve into the culture and partake in a learning experience of their choice, followed by the Sky Tram and Skywalk Hanging Bridges Tour in the Arenal Rainforest Reserve. Later that afternoon, relax at the Eco-Termales hot springs. The next day, families enjoy a learning experience as they take part in a private lecture by a local resident researcher conducting work on a delicate ecosystem, followed by a morning tour at Finca Julieta Farm. Later that day, enjoy a guided nature walk through the Los Angeles Private Cloud Forest, which covers two thousand acres of land sitting three thousand feet above sea level.

Families head to the Nicoya Peninsula where they participate in a second guided nature walk. Afterward, participate in a learning experience at a traditional piñata-making class.
