Perillo introduces Costa Rica

Italy specialist Perillo Tours has expanded its destination portfolio to include Costa Rica as part of a larger strategy to create a year-round product offering.

"Two years ago, we decided to expand our off-season product line," Steve Perillo, CEO of Perillo Tours, wrote in an email. "After two years of exploring, we hit upon Costa Rica -- a truly unique experience for the body, mind and soul ... There are only a few places on earth, where in just one week, you can experience the variety of landscapes, natural habitats and wildlife as you can in Costa Rica."

Perillo has added an eight-night Costa Rica itinerary with departures beginning in October and running through August 2014.

The itinerary begins in San Jose and includes Sarapiquí, a boat tour of the Tortuguero Jungle Canals, Arenal Volcano and Rainforest, San Ramon and Tango Mar.

The tour is \$1,890 per person, based on double occupancy, not including airfare; departure options with air out of New York and Miami can be arranged.

In addition to Italy, Perillo also sells Hawaii and now Costa Rica.
