Sailing the Galapagos

Vaya Adventures, for example, has a Dec. 23-30 sailing on its schooner-style yacht Beagle to the Galapagos Islands. Beagle, you may recall, was the name of Charles Darwin's ship on his famed explorations of the Galapagos, which are home to species found nowhere else in the world. Vaya offers various itineraries on the 14-passenger Beagle, but the Christmas departure will follow the South and Central itinerary, which visits numerous highlight spots, including the islands of Bartolome, Espanola and Floreana, among others. Varied adventures

AdventureSmith Explorations offers a variety of adventures over the holidays. A Hawaiian Seascapes cruise on a 36-passenger yacht runs Dec. 20-27, Dec. 27-Jan. 3 or Jan. 3-10. It explores four islands and has plenty of time for activities such as snorkeling, kayaking and hiking. It's \$3,595 per person double occupancy and can be found at tinyurl.com/q54g6rm. Wild Islands & Treasures of Baja California runs Dec. 20-27 or Dec. 27-Jan.3 on the 62-passenger National Geographic Seabird. Viewing humpback whales and hiking desert areas to see ancient native art are on the agenda. Price is from \$5,690 double occupancy, and details are at

tinyurl.com/nq9uk9l. Peru Mountain Lodge Trek can be booked over four dates covering the Christmas holiday. The trekking in the Andes naturally includes Machu Picchu. Priced from \$2,990 per person double occupancy, it's at tinyurl.com/ozcsapl. Quest for Pura Vida explores the mountains, rain forests and coastal areas of Costa Rica on two dates over Christmas. If you're looking for a more laid-back holiday, Perillo Tours has the 10-day/eight-night Marco Polo tour of Italy that runs Dec. 18-27. It's regularly priced at \$2,990 per person double occupancy, but for that date Perillo is offering a \$500 discount per person. Among cities visited are Venice, Padua, Florence, Siena and, finally, Rome, where you'll spend Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.
