This journey will begin in the capital of modern India, Delhi. Experience the juxtaposition of the ancient and modern as you explore monuments including the Red Fort, Humayun's Tomb, Qutab Minar, India Gate, the majestic Swaminarayan Akshardham Temple Complex and embark on an enthralling rickshaw ride through the bustling streets of Chandni Chowk. As a special opportunity, guests will help out in the langar or community kitchen of the most prominent Sikh house of worship, the

Bangla Sahib Gurdwara, which feeds close to 10,000 community members a day. The last night in Delhi will be spent at the home of a local family learning to cook traditional delicacies while discussing culture, customs and beliefs.

From Delhi guests are whisked off to Varnasi, India's most sacred city, dating back to the 6th century BC, making it one of the oldest cities in the world. At dusk guests will proceed to the ghats to witness the Ganga Aarti, a devotional ritual where locals light lamps made of candles and flowers and float them down the river resulting in a truly magical site. Early the next morning guests will embark on a boat ride down the Ganges where they will witness the devotees' ritual baths set amongst the backdrop of the rising sun.

The next few days will be spent in a luxury tented camp in Bodhgaya where guests will attend the Kalachakra festival, presided over by His Holiness the Dalai Lama. Roughly translated as "cycles of time," Kalachakra focuses on three cycles – external, internal and alternative – with the aim to gain liberation from the material world through meditation, prayers and rituals. Guests will have the opportunity to attend Kalachakra sessions and witness the Dalai Lama give his preliminary teachings.

As the trip comes to a close, the trip will stop in Varnasi where guests will visit Sarnath and its museum before heading to Delhi for one last tour at the Bharat Mata Temple followed by a lecture on Buddhism.

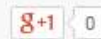
