New York City: Tall ships, ahoy! Hornblower Cruises, whose modern vessels offer sightseeing year-round, sails back in time July 5-12 with tours (\$15) of El Galeón (pictured), a replica of a 16th century Spanish ship. Chad: Encounter Tubu nomads watering their camels in dramatic gorges, salt-makers selling their wares by the Ounianga lakes and Gorane shepherds leading their flocks into the Sahara Desert on Mountain Travel Sobek's Ancient Caravans of Chad, departing Nov. 3. The 18-day tour (from \$6,175) is the first by a U.S. operator in the country. www.mtsobek.com.


Music festival

Slovenia: Piran Musical Evenings, the country's oldest chamber music festival, takes place at 9 p.m. Fridays in July at St. Francis Church, in the heart of Piran, a medieval city on the scenic Istrian peninsula. Mountain biking

Mexico: Ancient foot trails and dirt tracks in Oaxaca's 70,000-acre Sierra Norte provide room for mountain bikers to roam; H+I Adventures can provide routes and a week's home stay in one of eight Zapotec villages.
