THE TRIP: The seven-day guided tour takes guests to historic and breathtaking sites such as Krka National Park, Hvar and Ston, where the popular TV series *Game of Thrones* is filmed.

Also included is a visit to Split, site of the oldest archaeology museum in Croatia.

Guests will also spend a full day in Dubrovnik, which stands in for the Westros capital city of King's Landing in the series.

The package includes four-star accommodations, daily breakfast, land transportation, guides and some additional meals and wine-tastings. Travelers who book by June 15 will receive a Blu-ray/DVD set of the series, plus a set of five books by George R.R. Martin.
