Last year, fans of the hit HBO series [Game of Thrones](#) raced to [Spain](#) to catch a glimpse of its filming of [season 5](#). Over the last few seasons, the show has generated a wave of [tourism](#) in Northern Ireland, Iceland, Croatia, Malta and Morocco. With the release of season 5, it is expected to create a rise in tourism at its newest filming location: Spain.

[The Royal Alcázar of Seville](#) (also known as Real Alcázar de Sevilla) is an important location in the current season. This picturesque palace in Seville doubles as Dorne, the home of House Martell. The palace is complete with gardens, halls and amazing [Mudéjar](#) architecture. The upper levels are still being used by the Spanish royal family.

The Roman Bridge in [Cordoba](#), Spain was used as the Long Bridge of Volantis. It was built by the Romans in the early 1st century BC and is 247 meters long. The small town of [Osuna](#)'s bullring was used to portray the Arena of Meereen. Before the fifth season filming of [Game of Thrones](#), Osuna did not get many visitors. That will change soon enough!
